To address this issue, the IPAD project was launched by seven expert organisations from five countries -Spain, Portugal, Austria, Turkey and Ireland - working between October 2023 and September 2025 to co-create a collection of competences in social media literacy and Internet safety, develop an ICT-based training tool for adult educators and draft a set of guidelines to transfer the project results to interested parties.
